

## DOG ADOPTION-FIRST DAY CHECKLIST

The first day of dog adoption is an exciting and critical time for both you and your new furry companion.

To help ensure a smooth transition and a positive start to your journey together, this checklist will guide you through some important steps to make your new dog feel comfortable and secure in their new home.

From setting up a safe space to introducing them to their new surroundings, this outline will help you create a welcoming environment for your newest family member.

AREAS TO CONSIDER	CHECKLIST
Garden Exploration and Elimination	Take dog to garden upon arrival  Keep dog on lead  Allow dog to sniff and eliminate
Allowing Time for Adjustment	Allow dog space and time to settle in Interact calmly and quietly if approached Avoid rushing to interact
Avoiding Overstimulation	<ul><li>Avoid walking your dog on the first day or as soon as they arrive home. They need to bond with you first!</li><li>Limit visitors to only household members</li></ul>
Introductions with Existing Pets	<ul> <li>Ensure positive introduction with other pets</li> <li>Remove toys, beds, and food bowls</li> <li>Introduce pets to each other gradually</li> </ul>
Monitoring Activity Levels and Providing Comfort	<ul> <li>Monitor dog's activity levels</li> <li>Encourage rest and sleep</li> <li>Offer enrichment toys or scatter food for relaxation</li> </ul>
Calming First-Night Nervousness	<ul><li>Be prepared for a disturbed few nights of sleep</li><li>Consider allowing the dog to sleep in the same room as you, but only if you want this to continue long-term.</li></ul>
Seeking Support and Guidance	Reach out to sanctuary staff for guidance and support if needed
